Today's Speaker is Dr John Porter



John Porter is a Senior Scientist at the Office of Environment & Heritage and a Research Fellow at the Centre for Ecosystem Science, University of NSW. John has 30 years' experience in investigating plant community ecology in temporary and permanent wetlands and has described several new plant species he discovered. John has extensive experience in landscape scale monitoring of biodiversity including waterbirds and threatened plant communities in Australian rivers and wetlands. He has studied the ecology of threatened species in a range of remote areas from arid wetlands and oceanic islands, including Lord Howe Island. Recently John has been involved in monitoring the impact of introduced rodents on Lord Howe Island and its critically endangered cloud forests. The island's cloud forests support a large number of endemic and endangered plants and animals. John's talk will focus on the ecology of Lord Howe Island and some of the unusual and beautiful plants and animals that occur there. John was raised in the Blue Mountains and is currently a resident of Wentworth Falls.
